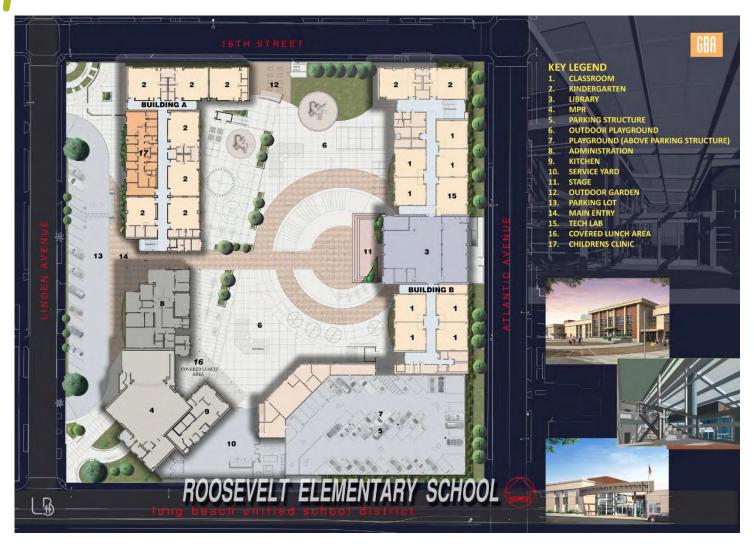

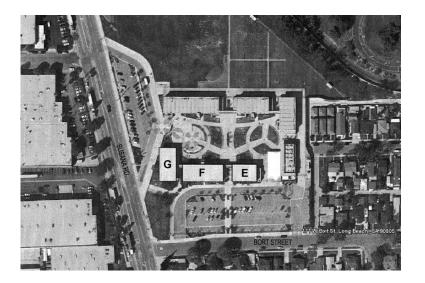

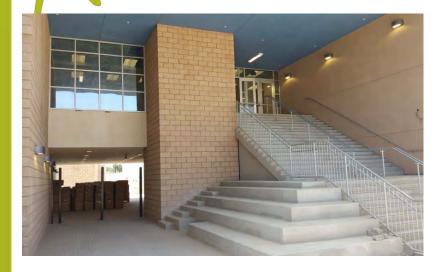
Proposed Site Plan

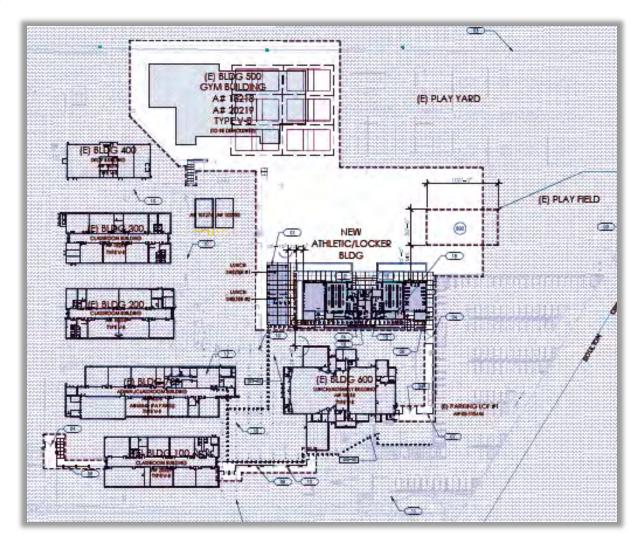
